

Immunization Requirements

Prior to enrollment, every child 5 to 19 years of age must have an immunization form which verifies the fact that the child has had the following immunizations:

diphtheria/pertussis/tetanus (DPT);

mumps/measles/rubella (MMR);

chicken pox;

polio;

Hepatitis A immunizations for kindergarten through 8th grade;

Hepatitis B immunization as required by law

All students who have lived outside the United States or have been home schooled are required to provide evidence that they have received at least one dose of the required vaccines.

All students entering kindergarten and 1st graders that are enrolling in school for the first time must show at least one dose of all required vaccines. Students entering the seventh grade are required to have a tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis (Tdap) booster shot. The Tdap shot has to be given at or after the 7th birthday. The Tdap is now required for 7th – 12th grade students.
