

What you need at registration:

- **Immunization updates** for your student. There have been changes to some of the grade levels this year. Please go to the Immunizations link to see what is required.
- **Medical Diagnosis:** If your student has a medical diagnosis requiring school management or needs daily medication while at school, you will need to provide the school with medical orders and/or the medication during registration week.
- **Change in Custody:** By law, both biological parents have education rights unless there is legal documentation showing otherwise. If there a change in custody status for your student or if the school does not have copies of custody paperwork, parenting plan, etc., please bring copies of the legal documentation to the school office.
- **Power of Attorney for School Purposes:** If you wish to delegate education duties or rights for your student to another adult, a Power of Attorney for School Purposes form needs to be notarized and turned in at the school office. The Power of Attorney is valid for 6 months and may be revoked, in writing, at any time.
- **Documents Needed for Kindergarten & 1st graders entering school or the first time:** Immunization records and verification of birth date (birth certificate, adoption papers, birth registration, passport, hospital birth record or court order) are required for these students.
- **New to the District Students:** New to the district students need verification of birth date and immunization records.
- **School Fees:** Money for school fees and swimming fees will be collected. See fee schedule. Cash, checks, credit and debit cards accepted.
