

PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS

The Pre-Participation Physical Examination mandate, ORS 336.479, requires that all students who participate in co-curricular activities requiring physical exertion have a physical examination every two years.

All students participating in co-curricular activities requiring physical exertion will be required annually to complete page one of a School Sports Pre-Participation Examination form, which must be on file at the school office prior to participation in the activity. Forms are available in the office of the Athletic Department, Marshfield High School, 10th & Ingersoll, Coos Bay.

An annual physical examination is necessary when a student has had a serious or chronic illness such as epilepsy, asthma, diabetes, chronic heart disease, including heart murmurs, or severe allergies. Students must submit an updated physical examination form if they have undergone major surgery.
