SEISMIC UPGRADES

Coos Bay School District received \$2.5 million from the state for seismic upgrades for MHS Auditorium and Main Gym. The upgrades will include new roofs with framing connected to the building, outer structure support. The gym is designated as a gathering place in case of natural disaster or emergency.

The district has allocated \$192K from the Capital Projects Fund to complete the seismic upgrade projects.
